



CLEANING SOLUTIONS

DIY TIPS

AIR FRESHENER FOR CARPETS: Equal parts baking soda and cornstarch can be sprinkled on smelly carpet or rug to freshen it. Vacuum after letting sit for about 30 minutes.

BAKING SODA EXPIRED?: Pour down the garbage disposal with running water to freshen it up. Keep nearby or take a small container on the go to soak up spills in the car, or on your clothes.

CLEAN GRATER: Clean soft cheese, garlic, or any other food from your grater by cutting a lemon in half and rubbing the pulpy side against the grater.

MAKE YOUR CUTTING BOARD NEW AGAIN: By rubbing a cut lemon wedge with salt onto the board.

INSTEAD OF BUYING RINSE AID: Add white vinegar to your dishwasher instead.

LABELS STUCK?: Saturate with white vinegar and then peel off.

TO PREVENT STAINING: Spray your Tupperware container with nonstick cooking spray before storing any dishes with a tomato-based sauce or any dish you think may stain.

CLEAN STAINED TUPPERWARE: With a paste made with baking soda and a little water. OR soak in soap with cold water overnight. Then rinse and wash.

CLEAN YOUR MICROWAVE: Microwave 1/2-cup lemon juice (or the juice of a fresh squeezed lemon mixed with 1/2-cup water) on high power 3 minutes. Carefully remove and wipe clean.

HOMEMADE REUSABLE DRYER SHEETS

- Clothes Softener:
- 2-3 cups water
- 1 cup liquid fabric softener
- 1 **Pick-A-Deli® Container**
- 1 sponge



Combine water and liquid fabric softener in **Pick-A-Deli® Container**. Cut a household sponge in half and soak pieces in softener mixture. Pull up the **Pick-A-Deli® Container** handle, and using one half of the sponge, squeeze to remove excess softener and toss in the dryer.

MAKEUP REMOVER

Makes 80 wipes

- 2 tbsp. coconut oil, melted
- 1 tbsp. baby wash
- 1 cup water
- Optional: 1/4 tsp. tea tree oil

80 ct. package cotton rounds

1. Stir together coconut oil, baby wash, water and tea tree oil, if using.
2. Divide cotton rounds between four **Snack Cups**. Some may not fit until after water mixture is poured over the cotton rounds.
3. Slowly pour water mixture over cotton rounds dividing evenly so all of cotton is soaked with mixture. Once there is room in **Snack Cups**, add any remaining cotton rounds and pour remaining water over rounds. Seal and store up to three months.



DIY HOMEMADE LAUNDRY DETERGENT

Total recipe yields 28 cups
1 **Tupper™ Mini** yields approximately 114 loads

- 4.1-lbs./1.8 kg box Borax
- 5-lbs./2.3 kg box baking soda
- 3.7-lbs./1.7 kg box super washing soda
- 3 bars Fels-Naptha Soap
- 3-lbs./1.3 kg tub OxiClean



1. Assemble **Grate Master™ Shredder** with fine cone attachment and place bowl underneath.
2. Grate each bar of Fels-Naptha Soap by placing it in hopper and pushing down with plunger as necessary. Repeat process with remaining bars until all of it is shredded.
3. Place all ingredients in **Thatsa® Mega Bowl**, seal and shake to evenly distribute.
4. Store laundry detergent in **Large Carry-All® with Handle**.
5. Measure and scoop using **Tupper™ Mini**.

ALL-PURPOSE ECO-FRIENDLY CLEANER

Makes 24 oz./709 mL solution

- 8 oz./237 mL water
- 8 oz./237 mL rubbing alcohol
- 8 oz./237 mL white vinegar

Combine ingredients in a **Slim Line Pitcher** and mix to combine.
